Pacific Sun Expands to Shanghai



(Hong Kong, December 11, 2007) – Pacific Sun Investment Management (“Pacific Sun”) is pleased to announce that Sage Brennan has joined as Director of Research and is based in Shanghai. Mr. Brennan will spearhead Pacific Sun’s research efforts on the mainland that will include analysts in Shanghai and Nanjing. He was previously General Manager of Shanghai-based Pacific Epoch, a boutique telecom and technology research firm and was also a technology research specialist BDA in Beijing where he advised on strategic approaches to investing in China. While at Pacific Epoch Mr. Brennan contributed the weekly “This Week in China” column to Dow Jones’ MarketWatch. He holds both an MBA and an undergraduate degree in International Studies from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and has been speaking and studying Mandarin since his first trip to Beijing in 1987.

Hong Kong-based Pacific Sun specializes in alternative investments in Asia with a specific concentration in greater China (China, Hong Kong, and Taiwan), and is investment advisor to The China Mantou Fund (the “Fund”). Pacific Sun’s founder and chief investment officer, Andy Mantel, was the founding Portfolio Manager for China’s first fund management firm Shanghai International Asset Management, a joint venture set up in 1992 between the Shanghai government and one of Taiwan’s largest business groups. He also helped in opening one of Taiwan’s first foreign institutional accounts in 1991.

“We are pleased that Mr. Brennan has joined Pacific Sun and he will play an instrumental role in developing our research efforts on the mainland to compliment our portfolio operations in Hong Kong” said Mr. Mantel. “Mr. Brennan brings a wealth of investment research experience to our firm and we look forward to further capitalizing on our common strengths in order to discover the best investment opportunities in China.”

The Fund’s board of directors and advisory members include a diverse and complimentary group of mostly greater China-based experts. The advisors are George Chen (Chairman/CEO of Taiwan’s Capital Group), Peter Fu (Former Managing Director of BNP Paribas Peregrine), T.L. Tsim (leading advisor on political risk and strategic planning in greater China) and Liu Xuezhong (Chairman of Zhong Tai Group in Nanjing).

Pacific Sun also added Louis Shi to its Hong Kong-based team as investment analyst. Mr. Shi is a Beijing native and has a B.A. in Global Studies from the University of California-Santa Barbara. During his studies he had various investments-related internships in Beijing, Shenzhen, and Hong Kong.
